## **Home & Hospital Tuition Service**



The service provides education for pupils who are experiencing ill-health or trauma of a psychological/psychiatric nature. We provide a safe and supportive environment where pupils can achieve their potential academically, emotionally and socially while they are unable to attend mainstream school.

We work collaboratively with family, community, external agencies and educational establishments to provide the most appropriate support for each pupil.

Parents/carers are always welcome to visit the centre. We encourage you to contact us if there are any matters which you wish to discuss.

### **We Offer**

- ◆ Stability to pupils who are experiencing ill-health or trauma of a psychological/psychiatric nature.
- ◆ A broad and balanced curriculum which is flexible and specific to the individual's needs.
- ◆ The opportunity for pupils to excel academically, to develop their creativity and enhance their emotional well-being.
- ◆ We aim to equip pupils with the life skills and resilience to enable them to cope with personal challenges.





## **Staffing:**

The service has experienced, specialist teachers who are trained to meet the needs of our particular pupils.

A School Nurse and Connexions Advisor have regular contact with pupils both in the Centre and on Home Tuition.

Pupils are also supported by two counsellors and caring administration staff as well as other agencies, including CAMHS.



## **We Deliver:**

- ◆ National Curriculum at key stages 1-4 on home tuition and in Sandwell General Hospital
- ◆ Full-time education in Albright Centre at key stages 3-4
- ◆ A variety of courses leading to GCSE, Entry Level, BTEC and Functional Skills qualifications
- ◆ Vocational subjects
- ◆ Career guidance
- ◆ A flexible work experience programme
- ◆ Access to a variety of training and college placements
- ◆ A variety of enrichment activities, including residential experiences



## **Subjects include:**

English, Maths, Science, ICT, French, Humanities, Food & Nutrition, Design & Technology, PSHE and Art. We also have a varied Enrichment programme.
