Home Learning Policy

Principles

Albright Education Centre believes that home learning is an opportunity to extend and explore topics learnt during lessons. It is designed to be purposeful, relevant and accessible and to enable pupils to discuss their experiences with parents or carers at home. Furthermore, the home learning challenges are designed to continue positive classroom experiences and help develop a life-long love of learning.

We recognise that there may be some barriers to accessing these learning opportunities and we endeavour to address these by:

- Presenting home learning tasks in a clear format that are easy to read for pupils and parents/carers
- Making tasks enjoyable and accessible
- Enable pupils to receive in school support with their tasks
- Providing relevant website links for pupils to access further information
- Allowing sufficient time for the tasks to be completed successfully
